We are looking for the best swimming teachers to join the team. Are you passionate, friendly and enthusiastic about swimming? As a swim school we want to emphasise quality in the lessons we deliver with smaller class sizes and excellent standards of teaching. To be successful you will need to have an “energetic” attitude, experience delivering lessons, excellent verbal communication skills and be flexible. Typical lessons take place after school and on weekends. There is also potential for cover during school hours and 1-2-1s available.

Applicants will need to meet the following requirements:

- An ASA Level 2/Swim England in teaching swimming or an STA Level 2 certificate in swimming teaching
- Exceptional communication skills and experience in a customer-facing environment, able to respond appropriately and professionally to everyone you interact with in all manner
- Excellent swimming ability with up-to-date knowledge of the sport
- Ideally the candidate will hold a valid National Reach Rescue Award / Pool Attendant Qualification or National Pool Lifeguard Qualification.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- To plan and deliver lessons ensuring adherence to the scheme of work and lesson plans as agreed by the swimming coordinator.
- Carry out all administrative tasks associated with your position, including lesson plans schemes of work and class registers
- Integration of the Swim England Learn to Swim programme reward schemes into your classes.
- Ensure safe provision of all equipment and ensure it is used correctly.
- Make sure safety standards are followed in all sessions and undertake risk assessments.
- Plan and deliver sessions appropriate to the level of swimmer.
- Provide explanations and demonstrate swimming techniques.
- Correct faults in swimming techniques and identify ways to improve performance.
- To be a positive role model, creating a positive and fun environment in which to motivate and encourage children and adults to participate in swimming.

- Regularly assess each participant's ability and progress and arrange for the award of the appropriate certificates.
- To attend meetings where required.
- Adhere, at all times, to Health and Safety legislation, and all departmental policies and procedures, to ensure their own safety and that of colleagues, pupils and visitors.

Tring School is popular and over-subscribed, serving the town of Tring and the surrounding villages. It is a mixed Church of England all-ability school, 1500+ on roll, over 300 Post-16.
